- Forgotten geography

- Educating for slow thinking
- Forms of intelligence for the future
- Education and the myths of our time
- Teaching autonomy of thought regardless of social models
- Teaching peace through disciplines

- Multilingualism and multiculturalism as cornerstones of the curriculum
- Learners' needs at the centre of curricula
- Developing new skills in education
- Reflections on transformation

The journal also welcomes:

- reviews of volumes related to the themes above
- research abstracts and studies of foreign original articles related to the themes above
- translations of articles related to the themes above
- reports of web-based documents (including audio or video) pertaining to the themes above
- artistic work as the end product of educational and/or training paths related to the themes above, accompanied by explanatory notes drafted by the teacher/teacher trainer (decorative panels, workstations, drawings, poems, stories, video recordings, podcasts etc.)
- interviews

Proposals should be sent by **30 April 2025** to <u>ideeinformazione@anfis.eu</u> based on the following:

- studies, research and reflections (no more than 35.000 characters, spaces, notes, abstracts and references included)
- reports of training practices and experiences (no more than 25.000 characters, spaces, notes, abstracts and bibliography included)
- book reviews (no more than 6.000 characters, spaces, indexes and author profile included)
- reflections of teachers in training (no more than 12.000 characters, spaces, notes, bibliography included) under the title *My most illuminating moment as a trainee* (if the teacher is trained in a foreign language, the title and the text will be written in the foreign language). The above title will be followed by a subtitle proposed by the author him/herself.

N.B. Authors are kindly invited to respect the guidelines regarding the length of the articles. Here are the deadlines for sending the contribution:

- 15 December 2024: submission of abstract
- 30 January 2025: submission of paragraphs with brief content
- 30 April 2025: submission of the article

The articles will be submitted for evaluation by two reviewers. Their evaluations, together with those of the editorial staff, will be returned to the authors by August 31st 2025. The Authors will have three weeks from the receipt of the evaluations to make changes and additions to their article based on the suggestions provided by the reviewers and the editorial staff. Authors are invited to send a file in which the changes made are still evident.
